BULK STICKER POLICY

1. All bulk pickup will require a sticker which shall be issued by the Clerk's Office. There shall be two types of stickers.
 - a. "Standard Bulk Sticker" for general bulk pickup by the Borough's contractor. (Example: sofa, chair, bed, lamp and so on).
 - b. "White Goods Sticker" bulk pickup by the Borough Department of Public Works. This sticker shall include refrigerators, washers, dryers or any product made of 90% metal. Contact the DPW to arrange the date of pickup.
2. Fees for stickers;
 - a. All stickers shall cost \$10.00 each with the appropriate proof of residency.
 - b. Seniors shall be entitled to two (2) free standard bulk stickers per household per year and any stickers required up and beyond the two free stickers shall be at the cost of \$10.00 per sticker. Seniors shall be entitled to an unlimited supply of "White Goods" bulk stickers per year.
 - c. Absolutely no refunds for any type of stickers.
3. Issuance of Stickers;
 - a. Stickers can be obtained in person at the Municipal Building Clerks Office between the hours of 9:00am to 4:30pm.
 - b. Stickers can also be requested via US Mail by submitting a letter of request accompanied by proof of residency and if applicable proof of senior status to the Clerk's Office at 111 River Styx Road, Hopatcong, New Jersey 07843. The request must include the proper fees for the number of stickers being requested. The request shall be processed within five (5) business days. The envelope should be marked "Bulk Sticker Request" for the Borough to comply with the 5 business day turnaround.
4. DPW Yard Bulk Drop off discontinued.
5. **Bulk Sticker for Additional Garbage Pickup in Excess of the Allotment.**
Standard Bulk Stickers may be utilized for additional garbage pickup by the Borough's Contractor. One (1) standard bulk sticker shall afford the property owner the ability to discard up to three (3) bags of garbage per sticker. The additional three bags cannot be placed in a container; the sticker must be visible to the contractor picking up the garbage. This is in effect as of July 16, 2009.
