Mary read the Resolution Grant Agreement to the board members. Marty Janowski made a motion to approve the Commission Resolution Grant Agreement between Hopatcong Environmental Commission and the State of New Jersey. Bernice Gleason seconded the motion and all were in favor.

APPROVAL OF THE MARCH 24, 2004 MINUTES

April 21, 2004 - Tidal Wave Bar & Grill, 1 - 500 gal. unregulated tank removed and clean up was completed.

Mary Takacs received a letter from ANJEC informing the Commission of the available matching grants for Smart Growth Planning for up to \$25,000.00.

The DEP sent a copy of a letter to Mayor Hodson that was addressed to Mr. Frank Scalley notifying him that he is in violation at 310 Squaw Trail. He is required to the removal, excavation or disturbance of the soil; dumping or filling with any material;

erection of structures; placement of pavements; destruction of plant life; and placement of any portion of a residential development project within a freshwater wetland transition area which require permit approval.

Connie Janowski made a motion to pay the Musconetcong Water Shed Association Renewal at \$100.00. Elizabeth Mauro seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Mary received a letter from the Sussex County Agriculture Development Board informing the Commission of the newly released Sussex County Comprehensive Farmland Preservation Plan and Sussex County Open Space and Recreation Report.
