Medicare Prescription – Part D Annual Open Enrollment is Almost Over!

October 15 through December 7, 2025

Open Enrollment for Part D Medicare will end December 7th! The Division of Senior Services strongly recommends that you create a *MyMedicare* account by visiting *MyMedicare.gov*. Your *MyMedicare* account allows you to save information such as your prescription drug list. You can also view your claims and view a calendar of preventative services that you may be eligible to receive.

If you do not have access to a computer, our State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) counselors at the Division of Senior Services are available to help you compare coverages and possibly change your Medicare plans for 2026. Our SHIP counselors provide free, unbiased information and assistance to people with Medicare.
